

# Learning Management System (manaba) User Guide

## 1. What is a learning management system

The Learning Management System (LMS for short) is a system for distributing course materials, managing report assignments, and checking attendance through a Web interface. University of Tsukuba has introduced manaba as a learning management system. In a class with LMS, when students and teachers register for classes on the system, they will be able to access a web page called a “course page” prepared for that class.

## 2. How to login

Any student at the University of Tsukuba can use manaba. (User registration is not required.) To log in to the system, follow steps (1) to (3) below.

(1) Access the manaba login page (URL below).

(2) When the login screen of the University of Tsukuba Unified Authentication System (as shown in the figure below) is displayed, enter your ID (13-digit number on the barcode on the back of your staff ID or student ID) in the “User ID” field and the password in the “Password” field.

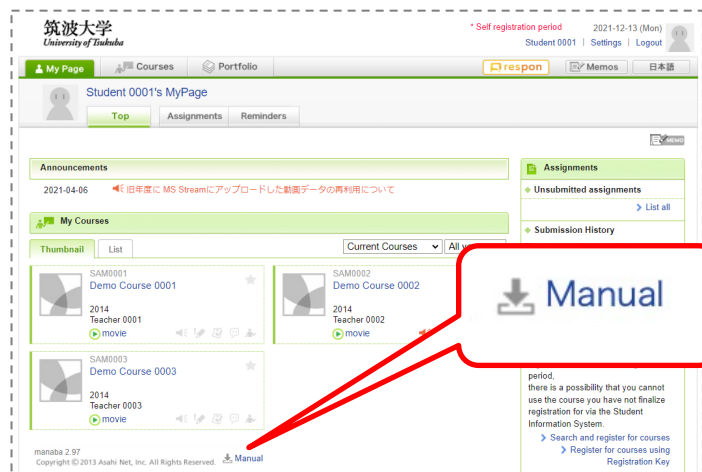
(3) If you log in successfully, “My Page” is displayed. If you are a faculty member, the list of classes you are in charge of is displayed. If you are a student, the list of classes you are taking is displayed.
